Fees payable for the Celebration of Civil Marriages in the Marriage Hall and Outside Civil Status Office Premises

1. Members of the public are hereby informed that as from 01 May 2022 the fees for the celebration of civil marriages are applicable as follows: -

1. Where both of the intending spouses are citizens of Mauritius, celebration	FEES (Rs)
of civil marriage at –	
a) the marriage hall	500
b) any private residence	1,500
c) premises other than a private residence or the marriage hall	2,000
2. Where both of the intending spouses are non-citizens, celebration of	
civil marriage at –	
a) the marriage hall	3,000
b) any private residence	5,000
c) premises other than a private residence or the marriage hall	5,000
3. Where one of the intending spouses is a citizen of Mauritius and the	
other intending spouse is a non-citizen, celebration of civil marriage at –	
a) the marriage hall	2,000
b) any private residence	2,000
c) premises other than a private residence or the marriage hall	2,500

^{3.} The duplicate payment receipt should be handed over to the Officer in Charge of the Civil Status Office where the publication of marriage has been made at least 3 days before the date fixed for the celebration of marriage. Arrangements regarding the time and place of marriage should be agreed upon with the officer.

- 4. The attention of the public is also drawn to the following: -
 - (a) For each marriage celebrated outside the Civil Status Office, the officer is paid an allowance by Government. Hence no additional fee is payable to the officer. However, as per the Civil Status Act 198 Section 35 (b) (ii), a means of conveyance to and from the private premises should be provided to the officer, on request; and
 - (b) any civil marriage celebrated during office hours at any civil status office except the Marriage Hall at Central Civil Status Office is free of charge.
 - (c) celebration of civil marriages in the Marriage Hall at the Central Civil Status Office will be held only on weekdays from 08.45 to 16.00 hours
